Objectives

Reading/Writing:

- Identify and explain literary elements such as plot and theme.

- Determine the meaning of a root word using prefixes and suffixes.
- Write a composition (on a genre of their choice) using the pre-writing process.

Math:

- Use math drawings to compose a rectangle with square tiles.
- Partition a rectangle into same-size squares, and compose arrays with the squares.
- Relate doubles to even numbers, and write number sentences to express the sums.

Science:

- Draw a diagram and label the parts of a seed.
- Make observations of plants and animals to compare the diversity of life in different habitats.
- Identify the science and engineering concepts behind building a strong sand castle.

Social Studies:

- Recognize tools and resources used to learn about history.
- Identify Native American cultures from different regions.
- Compare life in the past to life today.
