Items Discussed:

8th Grade Field Trip 2023 - Mrs. Emmons joined the meeting to explain the changes to the trip that have occurred over the years. Before 9/11, the trip was an overnight trip to Boston. After 9/11, there were concerns about the safety of a trip to a major city so the destination was changed to Gettysburg. Then the pandemic caused the cancellation of overnight trips, and the parents became involved in choosing what the students should do as an alternative. The trip should be tied to the curriculum. Mrs. Emmons suggested offering parents the choice of Gettysburg or Boston as an overnight trip tied to the curriculum going forward.

The committee agreed with her proposal.

State Special Education Survey - F16 - This is a special education survey distributed by the federal government for randomly selected states. The government selected NJ as one of the states and the state DOE selected Garwood as one of the districts to survey. The survey will go out to parents in June. Any parent who had a student enrolled in the special education program in 2020-2021 will receive the survey (October 2020 enrollment reports will be used).
